

10 Pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, I respectfully request access to in-election
11 log data generated by all Optical Scanners and Voting Kiosks used in Wards 1 through 50 for the
12 upcoming November 5, 2024, General Election. This request includes all data logs made available in
13 accordance with the Voluntary Voting System Guidelines (VWSG 2.0) upon conclusion of the election,
14 specifically:

15 Section 11.1-A: Logging activities and resource access, including timestamped entries and all
16 successful or unsuccessful system access attempts.

17 Section 15.1-A: Log entries to support continuous monitoring and analysis, with all logs
18 exportable for external review.

19 Section 15.1-C: Safeguards ensuring logs do not capture voter-identifying information to
20 maintain voter privacy and ballot secrecy.

21 Section 15.1-D: Minimum event logging requirements and specific logged events for system
22 operations, including voting events.

25 I am an individual conducting investigative research for non-commercial purposes in the
26 public interest.

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
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
